**Results:**

Texas Southmost College (TSC) regularly tracks enrollment headcount through the Office of Institutional Planning, Research and Effectiveness. Criteria data for this outcome were derived from the Fall 2016 Texas Higher Education Accountability System as part of TSC’s Vision 2023. From Fall 2016 to Fall 2019, total student enrollment increased 70.4% from 5,062 to 8,628. In addition, the growth between males and females has been steady and somewhat similar from Fall 2016 to Fall 2019.
