- Goal:** Increase or maintain course completion
- Vision 2023 Goal:** Foster Student Success
- Criteria:** Increase the percentage of course completion by 1%
- Threshold of Acceptability:** Expected to be greater than the baseline and/or previous year’s results, depending on which is greater

Percentage of Course Completion

Percentage of course completers based on census date contact hours versus end of semester contact hours.

Results:

Texas Southmost College (TSC) regularly tracks the percentage of course completion through the Office of Institutional Planning, Research and Effectiveness. Criteria data for this outcome were derived from the 2018 Data Resources for Legislative Budget Board (LBB) Performance Measures from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board. While TSC has not seen an increase in course completion, the institution has been able to maintain an overall 92% course completion for the past three years.
