



Student Achievement – Licensure

- Goal:** Increase state licensure exams passage rate
- Vision 2023 Goal:** Foster Student Success
- Criteria:** Increase the state licensure exam passage rates to above 80%.
- Threshold of Acceptability:** Expected to be greater than the baseline and/or previous year’s results, depending on which is greater

Percentage of Who Pass a Licensure Exam

Results:

Texas Southmost College (TSC) regularly tracks the percentage of those student who pass a licensure exam through the Office of Institutional Planning, Research and Effectiveness. Criteria data for this outcome were derived from the 2018 Data Resources for Legislative Budget Board (LBB) Performance Measures from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board. TSC was able to increase the passage rate from 78.7% in 2016 to 83.5% in 2017. In 2018, the passage rate dropped by 1%, but the institution maintained an above 80% passage rate.
